For since he possessed Your strength, he cast down the tyrants and wholly destroyed the demons' strengthless presumption. O Christ God, by his prayers, save our souls, since You art merciful. (SAM)*

**Apolytikion of St. George: 4<sup>th</sup> Tone** (back of Green Hymnal)

*As the deliverer of captives, and the protector of the poor; a physician of the sick, the defender of kings; O Great Martyr St. George Victorious, intercede to Christ our God, to save our souls.*

**Kontakion of Forefeast of Meeting of our Lord: 4<sup>th</sup> Tone (Feb 1)**

*On this day does Symeon receive with gladness God, the Giver of the Law; and he does cry to Him in fear: Let me depart now, O Master Christ, for I have seen You, the Glory of Israel. (SAM)*
