“What gift are we offering to Him this Christmas?” In the Christmas carol, “The Little Drummer Boy” it says “I have no gift to bring ... that’s fit to give a king ... shall I play for you ... on my drum?” The realization that he has no material gift to bring - but that he has the gift of himself, his talent to offer - is so beautiful. The Little Drummer Boy feels almost sad at his meager gift. The baby Jesus receives this gift with joy: “Then He smiled at me.” And then the Little Drummer Boy realizes that his gift was acceptable to Christ, because it was the gift of himself.
