We hope that you are enjoying your summer holidays and our letter finds you in good health. Greek School classes will begin on Thursday, September 16, 2021 at 4:00pm, with an *Agiasmo Blessing*.

Please find enclosed our updated "Greek School Registration Procedures and Forms" for the upcoming 2021-2022 Greek School year. This year again, we aim to complete the registration process before the first day of school. It is kindly requested that you properly fill out all the attached forms to complete your registration either in person or by mail. We would like to draw your attention to the following:

We kindly ask that you comply with these procedures in order to ensure a smooth registration for all involved. ***Please be reminded that as per school policy, everyone is to enter and exit through the GYM doors only throughout the school year unless otherwise indicated.*** Parents please do not drop off students or park in front of the Church or in the handicap spots. On 9/16/21, we will first gather in the gym area prior to entering the Church. Following the blessing service, the students will proceed to their respective classrooms. Parents, please be on time to pick up your child in the GYM at the regular dismissal times as stated on the attached documents.

We are looking forward to seeing all of our Greek School students back in our classrooms at our St. George Greek School! It has been decided that we will continue with the technology learned by our staff members that supports our classrooms in Greek language learning - while we return in September with in person instruction. There was a positive and effective outcome with the use of technology by both our parents and students, and therefore, we will continue to be using these components in our instruction. (For examples, we will continue to use Zoom on snow days; Google Classroom for part of Classwork, Homework, Assessments and Grades; The Ellinopoula online platform for supplemental Greek teaching techniques and effective interactive student learning.)

- REGISTRATION CAN BE SENT OR DELIVERED TO THE CHURCH OFFICE ON OR BEFORE MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 13th, 2021.
- ANY OUTSTANDING GREEK SCHOOL TUITION AND STEWARDSHIP BALANCES FROM PREVIOUS YEARS MUST BE PAID IN FULL BEFORE REGISTERING FOR THE UPCOMING 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR.

**FOR RETURNING STUDENTS: UPON FULL PAYMENT OF YOUR REGISTRATION, YOUR CHILD WILL BE OFFICIALLY REGISTERED AND WILL BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND CLASS ON THE FIRST DAY OF GREEK SCHOOL. YOUR REGISTRATION MUST BE RECEIVED ON OR BEFORE MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 13TH IN ORDER FOR YOUR CHILD TO ATTEND CLASS ON THE FIRST DAY. THERE WILL BE NO REGISTRATION FOR RETURNING STUDENTS ON THE FIRST DAY OF CLASSES.
