Dear Parishioner,

As we are approaching Memorial Day we would like to kindly remind everyone of our obligation to maintain the grounds at the Annunciation Cemetery and from time to time do whatever improvements are needed. Due to the pandemic our last request for donations was May, 2019.

We have set up a fund to help with part of the regular cemetery maintenance but additional funds are needed as we have expanded the grounds. With the expansion in place we have additional maintenance cost:

- 1) Larger area to mow, fertilize, and maintain.
- 2) Grub treatment for the entire cemetery as part of the regular maintenance

Areas that we would like to work on this year are outlined below.

- 1) Cut-in an “access” road in the new section
- 2) Hydro-seeding areas of the old section that still have sparse grass growth
- 3) Complete planting trees for separation along the power lines and the highway
- 4) Improving the altar area
- 5) Additional water lines
